WHY DOES THE VOICE HAVE TO BE IN THE CONSTITUTION?

THE ULURU STATEMENT CALLS FOR A VOICE TO PARLIAMENT TO BE ENSHRINED IN THE AUSTRALIAN CONSTITUTION BY WAY OF A ENABLING PROVISION.

PREVIOUS FIRST NATIONS' REPRESENTATIVE BODIES SUCH AS ATSIAC WERE SET UP ADMINISTRATIVELY OR BY LEGISLATION. THAT MEANT THEY WERE EASILY ABOLISHED BY SUCCESSIVE GOVERNMENTS DEPENDING ON THEIR PRIORITIES.

SETTING UP AND THEN ABOLISHING REPRESENTATIVE BODIES CUTS ACROSS PROGRESS, DAMAGES WORKING RELATIONSHIPS AND WASTES TALENT THAT COULD BE USED TO SOLVE COMPLEX PROBLEMS.
