

WHERE DID THE ULURU STATEMENT COME FROM?

THE ULURU STATEMENT BUILDS ON THE HISTORY OF INDIGENOUS ADVOCACY FOR A BETTER FUTURE BASED ON JUSTICE AND SELF-DETERMINATION.

IN MAY 2017 ON THE 50TH ANNIVERSARYOF THE 1967 REFERENDUM FIRST NATIONS FORGED A HISTORIC CONSENSUS ON STRUCTURAL REFORM AND CONSTITUTIONAL CHANGE.

THIS WAS A GROUND-BREAKING PROCESS WITH FIRST NATIONS FROM ACROSS AUSTRALIA THROUGH 12 DELIBERATIVE DIALOGUES REPRESENTATIVE OF LOCAL TRADITIONAL OWNERS INDIGENOUS COMMUNITY-BASED ORGANISATIONS AND INDIGENOUS LEADERS.

THESE DIALOGUES SELECTED THEIR OWN REPRESENTATIVES TO ATTEND THE FIRST NATIONS CONSTITUTIONAL CONVENTION AT ULURU BY AN OVERWHELMING CONSENSUS MORE THAN 250 DELEGATES ADOPTED THE ULURU STATEMENT.
